Dear Campers and Parents,

Camp Kinneret-Biluim continues to enjoy a stellar reputation, and ranks among the most successful camps in North America.

This summer, with the financial support of many families and members of our community, we renovated half of our camper cabins and we will be renovating the remaining cabins this fall so that every cabin is ready to go for the summer of 2012. We also blazed a new path that leads from the cabin area, through the forest, over the river and all the way to our new sports fields. These new fields witnessed the introduction of our new athletics program where our campers enjoyed team sports and learned about the importance of exercise and living a healthy lifestyle. Our kids also enjoyed greater access to all of our activities and of course, the powerful experience that is Camp Kinneret. CAMP KINNERET REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Campers from the summer of 2011 and their siblings are given priority to register until September 30, 2011 on a first come first served basis. Campers that were registered in 2011 that wish to switch to a different session for 2012 are given priority to do so on the 30th of September providing space is still available in that session. After this date, we open up registration to new campers, also on a first come first served basis. All applications are kept in the order in which they arrive at our office and acceptance is based upon availability in each cabin. Please mail the enclosed registration forms, initial deposit and all post dated checks to our office using the enclosed return envelope.

CAMP KINNERET CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT
(One form per family)

The success of Camp Kinneret (the “Camp”) depends in large part upon the commitment and participation of every camper. In order to best attain this goal of success, the Camp has determined that all campers and their parents/guardians must agree to comply with the following Code of Conduct. The Camper and the Parents/Guardians of the camper hereby acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. The Camper will not use or be in possession of alcohol, drugs (other than drugs prescribed to the Camper before or during Camp which are under the supervision of the Camp’s medical professional), or drug related paraphernalia, including but not limited to rolling papers and pipes.
2. The Camper will not use or be in possession of cigarettes or other tobacco products.
3. The Camper will respect all areas of the Camp that are considered off limits and will not leave the campgrounds unless under staff supervision.
4. The Camper understands that the Camp’s program is mandatory and agrees to be a positive and active participant in the entire program.
5. The Camper will not vandalize, steal or abuse any property that is not his/hers.
6. The Camper will not use or be in possession of a cellular telephone, pager or other communication device during the Camp session.
7. The Camper will not light matches, lighters, burn mosquito coils or operate a kettle unless a staff member has given permission to do so.
8. The Camper will refrain from any behavior that Camp staff deems to be unacceptable and/or detrimental to the Camp program.

I have read the Code of Conduct Agreement and fully understand that my Camper’s participation in this program is contingent on the his/her adherence to the above noted rules and policies. I further confirm that I have reviewed this Code of Conduct with my Camper(s) and I am satisfied that my Camper(s) understand the terms of the Agreement and I have no reason to believe that my Camper(s) will be unable to comply with such terms.

I understand that the Camp will not refund any portion of the camp fees or related costs if my Camper is dismissed from Camp. While the Camp will cooperate with the parents/guardian with respect to the Camper’s return home, the Camp cannot and will not assume any liability in connection therewith. All costs and expenses, including, but not limited to, lodging out of camp, transportation and food necessarily incurred in connection with the Camper’s dismissal from the Camp (including, if applicable, any costs of a Camp staff escort) shall be billed to and immediately paid for by the undersigned who agree to be jointly and severally liable for all such costs. Furthermore, I agree to be responsible for all costs or charges or damages incurred by the Camp or any of its campers or staff as a result of any vandalism or theft for which the Camper is responsible.

We understand that this agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the province of Quebec and the courts of the Judicial District of Montreal shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of any proceeding in connection with this agreement.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS
(One form per family)

1. Campers from the summer of 2011 and their siblings are given priority to register until September 30, 2011 on a first come first served basis. Campers registered in 2011 that wish to switch from one session to another are given priority to do so on the 30th of September providing space is available in that session. After this date, we open up registration to new campers also on a first come first served basis. All applications from new inquiries are kept in the order in which they arrive at our office and acceptance is based upon availability in each cabin. Applicants who are not accepted are placed on a waiting list.
2. This application is the sole means of applying for registration at Camp Kinneret. Upon camp's receipt of the deposit and post-dated cheques, space will be reserved for the above mentioned child(ren). A deposit of \$500.00 must accompany each application. The deposit includes a \$150.00 non-refundable registration fee. If the application is cancelled on or before February 28, the deposit (minus the registration fee) and any fees paid will be refunded. If your child's registration is withdrawn on or before March 1st, the full deposit will be forfeited, if withdrawn after April 1st, then there will be no refund and all fees must be paid. All tuition fees must be paid in full by April 1st, or the enrolled child's space may be lost. The camp reserves the right to charge a late payment fee of \$100.00 on overdue accounts.
3. Any change to the session enrolled for shall be deemed a cancellation. However, no cancellation fee shall be charged if the enrollment is changed to a full summer session.
4. The Camp Director has sole discretion, and reserves the right, to dismiss any camper – WITHOUT REFUND – who willfully disregards camp rules, or who endangers the campers' and others' safety, or who otherwise fails to meet the character requirements of camp as set out in the Camp Kinneret Code of Conduct Agreement. All additional transportation costs incurred as a result, are the responsibilities of the parents/guardians.
5. Camp accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to any camper's property incurred during the session or while in transit.
6. Camp Kinneret is a non-profit organization whose costs for food, staff and program are fixed; we cannot issue refunds for an incomplete session for any reason.
7. The parent or guardian of each child certifies that his/her child is potty trained and is healthy and socially and psychologically ready for a resident summer camp experience. Parents must fully complete and return the parent questionnaire and medical forms provided by the camp, including obtaining any necessary physician's signatures.
8. Campers are placed into cabins by grade and age. Requests will be honored when possible, at the discretion of the Camp Director or his designate.
9. Parents agree that Camp Kinneret may use any photograph, video, image, likeness, utterance or statement in which the participant may appear to be involved, in whole or part, in any media, including the internet, for promotional or other purposes, without approval by or compensation to the participant or parent.
10. The family agrees to adhere to the Camp Kinneret policies regarding the sending of food items to campers as set out in the Parent's Handbook.
11. Parents/guardians give the camp permission to take the camper from the campsite for camp programs and/or medical treatment.
12. In case of an emergency, every effort will be made to contact the parents. If this is impossible, parents grant permission to the camp selected physician to hospitalize, to secure proper treatment and to order injection, anesthesia or surgery for the child.
13. This agreement shall be interpreted and subjected to the laws of the province of Quebec. It is hereby agreed by and between the parties that in the event of any dispute arising out of this agreement, or any other dispute between the parties, that jurisdiction shall at all times be in and remain in any court of competent jurisdiction located within Montreal, Quebec, and any legal proceedings brought by either party to enforce such rights must be brought in said city and province.

All of the information in this package is true and I have read and agree to the terms listed above.
